

Bhog Sandesh | May 10, 2026 via Mohini Didi | Mother's Day

Om shanti.

At the Confluence Age, every day is special. But we also have extra special days, and this day is one of those: Mother's Day!

As I went to Baba to offer Bhog, I came in front and Baba was giving the very love-filled drishti as the Mother and Father...the drishti of a Parent. Baba, with that deep love, was looking at all of us as a big family – but also seeing each one personally. Through His drishti, Baba was filling each of us with very beautiful, spiritual love.

When Baba looked at me, I was also absorbed in that powerful, loveful drishti. I told Baba that we bring this Bhog with all the love of the mothers, and also the love of the brothers. Baba accepted the Bhog, with its fragrance of everyone's love and remembrances.

Then Baba said: What you have received from Baba in this spiritual birth is so much spiritual love. So what will you share with others? You always share with others what you yourself have received; love. But there is a difference between lokik love and spiritual love. In lokik love, there is both happiness and sorrow. In spiritual love, there is only joy and happiness. So you can instantly know from this if the love is lokik, or spiritual.

Love in general is a power. But **spiritual love has the power of upliftment**. The support you can give through spiritual love is like the herb of life. Especially at this time, it's very unique and powerful when we share this spiritual love.

Anyone you come in contact with, even if not explaining knowledge, you can share so much through your spiritual drishti, based on your spiritual awareness. And even when speaking knowledge or serving – what souls want to experience is God's Love. There is soul conscious love, and then there is God's Love.

Baba again gave drishti, looking at all the children everywhere. He was giving a gift on Mother's Day...**the gift of spiritual love through spiritual drishti**. This is a gift He would like us to share with all.

What is lacking these days in the service of others? Baba invited each one of us to reflect on when we first came to Baba...and how much we received: faith, intoxication, belonging, love. We received so much that we were able to renounce so much. If you want to see this same result for those you serve, you have to do the same. Give what you received from Baba, such that renunciation is possible. And this giving is not limited to just when sharing knowledge, but while doing everything.

The second important aspect Baba shared on was atmosphere. Vibrations are very subtle. **We need to be able to create such vibrations that there is the constant experience of peace, cooperation**. Make a list of what kind of experience we should create through the atmosphere. Not just in Baba's Home, but wherever we are. What does my very presence create? Any virtue I myself have – peace, patience – that is the vibration and atmosphere than can be created.

In the world now, there is lots of tension, fear, stress, and turbulence (both internally and externally). Whatever Baba given you, you must remain in that state: peaceful, loveful. In any situation. Turmoil can also be internal: settling of karmic accounts which creates fluctuation, disturbance and uncertainty in the mind. **You now have to be free...go above all that**. Remain unshakeable and immovable. You have gone beyond the big, gross things...now only the small subtle things remain.

Baba wants all His children to become **worthy of constantly receiving blessings** – from Baba, and everyone. From Baba, you can receive mercy, love and blessings. Baba is the Bestower of Blessings. But Baba wants you to be

worthy of receiving blessings, not through His merciful and loveful form...but through having mercy and love for the self. Constantly be worthy of receiving blessings from Baba. Yes, parents always bless their children, so this is also what Baba does. **But it's up to me if I become an image of blessings.**

Baba finally spoke of two titles, as gifts for the mothers on this special day:

1. Yagya Mata (Mother of the Yagya): have love for and sustain the Yagya
2. Shiv Shakti: powerful form

Mothers are incognito and humble, which is good, but also remember that mothers have the inner power of a Shiv Shakti.

Baba is not forgetting about the Pandavs...they have their own day. Today is Mother's Day! But Baba also gave lots of love and remembrances to the Pandavs.
